As well as a busy practice, over 80% of which is devoted to Homoeopathy, he has lectured at

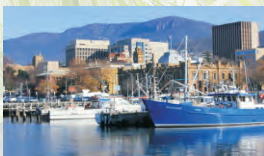
the Canadian College of Homeopathic Medicine since 1997. Publications include a monthly peer reviewed article for Naturopathic News and Review.
